#### Water Conservation:

How much water does the average person use?

In the home, each person uses 70 gallons of water a day.

It takes three gallons to flush a toilet.

It takes 15 to 30 gallons to take a bath.

It takes five gallons for a one minute shower.

It takes 10 gallons to wash dishes.

## Tips to Save Water:

Use a WaterSense shower head.

Purchase a Toilet Flush Conservation Kit.

Check faucets and showerheads for leaks.

Look for Energy Star washing machine and dishwasher.

# **Nathan's Maintenance Tips**

## Replace Faucet Aerator:

Sooner or later the aerator on every faucet gets clogged with debris and or calcium deposits.

### Replace Flapper in Toilet:

If you're not ready to replace your old toilet and just need a tune-up, start with your flapper. The flapper is the flexible seal that keeps the water in the tank from leaking into the bowl. When you flush, the flapper is lifted by the chain and flush lever, and the water from the tank flows down into the bowl. Typical flappers don't last very long and are the cause of most problems and leaks in a toilet.
